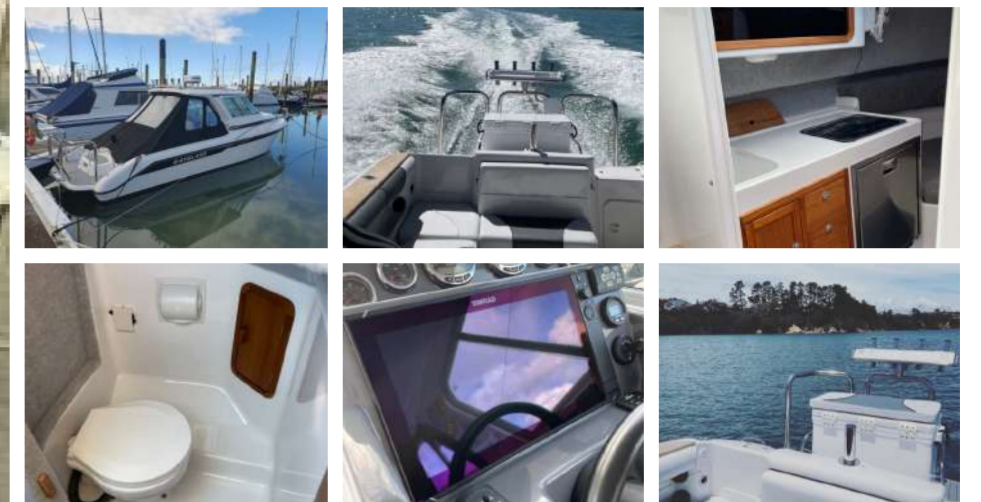

Winning the 2015 Boat of the Show Award, the Rayglass 2800 has been given the recognition it deserves, as over 200 owners can attest to. Particular attention has been put on the layout to make the best use of space. This has worked exceptionally well as the design of the cabin and helm area really open up the cabin, and give more space for a larger galley - 2 people can now easily stand together. The galley offers a variety of features such as a moulded condiment rack crockery storage, a 65-litre fridge, a fold-out teak table that extends the working space, a 2-burner stove, and a set of drawers below. Large double berth, MerCruiser 260hp. This example has all the usual Rayglass 2800 features plus: Drail with removable corner rails, 3-piece removable transom seats, Icytek bin & rails, BBQ including mount & gas bottle, 230 dinghy with snap davits. Simrad Halo 20+ Radar with Simrad GS25 GPS Antenna for Map Overlay. Additional house battery (1 x Start 2 x House), ProMariner 3 x 20a battery charger fitted. Shore Power with galvanic isolator. Seadek fitted. Fusion MS-RA770 with Signature 5 channel Amp, 10" Signature Sub plus 6 x Signature 6.5" speakers. Sounds amazing!! Solar panels.
